EXHIBIT A.

ADDITIONS TO THE "MINIMUM STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR SUBDIVISION DEVELOPMENT, BAXTER COUNTY, ARKANSAS".

I. Page 2, Chapter 2, Article C - Building Line:

Following the original statement/definition the following shall be added:

Minimum Building Setback Lines shall be: 30 feet from the front, 25 feet from the rear, and 10 feet from the side unless an easement of 15 feet exists, then no set back line on that side will be required.

II. Page 6, Chapter 4, <u>Sketch Plan & Plat Requirements</u>, Article 4-2 - Information to be shown on Preliminary and Final Plat -Number 12 - Location of building lines:

Following the original statement the following shall be added:

Minimum Building Setback Lines are: 30 feet in the front, 25 feet in the rear, and 10 feet on the side(s), unless an easement of 15 feet exists, then no set back lines on the side(s) will be required.
