

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 55

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT
OF THE COUNTY OF CARROLL, STATE OF
ARKANSAS, TO BE ENTITLED:

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CARROLL COUNTY
JAIL ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the citizens of Carroll County, in recognition of
the current state of affairs in the Carroll County Jail, have recently
voted in a Quorum Court sponsored $\frac{1}{2}$ of one percent cent sales
tax; and

WHEREAS, it is the now the responsibility of the Executive
Branch of Carroll County government to provide for the best use
of such tax revenues in the building of a new county jail; and

WHEREAS, the Carroll County Judge needs the best
information and advice available from knowledgeable Carroll
County citizens in order to complete the process of building the
new Carroll County Jail:

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
QUORUM COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

SECTION 1: Creation.

Pursuant to Arkansas Annotated 14-14-705 there is hereby
created the Carroll County Jail Advisory Board (CCJAB). The
CCJAB is created for the express purpose of advising the Carroll

County Judge, as he requires, on any and all aspects of constructing and maintaining the new Carroll County Jail.

SECTION 2: Membership and Terms of Service.

- (a) The CCJAB shall consist of six (6) members, two appointed by the Carroll County Judge, and one each appointed by the mayors of Berryville, Eureka Springs, Green Forest and a representative of Holiday Island who will be appointed by the District Manager. Appointment to the CCJAB shall not require Quorum Court approval.
- (b) Each board member shall be a qualified elector of Carroll County.
- (c) Board appointments shall be for staggered three-year terms
- (d) Board members shall not be appointed for more than two (2) consecutive terms
- (e) Each board member shall subscribe to the oath of office within ten (10) days of appointment and cause evidence of such oath to be filed in the office of the Carroll County Clerk.

SECTION 3: Conduct of affairs of the CCJAB.

- (a) The Carroll County Judge through written notification of each board member shall establish the time and place for the initial meeting of the CCJAB.
- (b) All subsequent meetings and the conduct of affairs of each meeting, including the initial meeting, of the CCJAB shall, on that date and thereafter, conform to the rules governing the conduct of the affairs of county boards found at Arkansas Code Annotated 14-14-707.

SECTION 4: Removal of CCJAB Board Members.

- (a) CCJAB Board members may be removed from the CCJAB by the County Judge for cause with a written

confirmation, in the form of a County Resolution, from the Carroll County Quorum Court.


- (b) Written notification stating the causes for removal shall be provided to the board member prior to the date established for quorum Court consideration of removal.
- (c) The Board member shall be afforded the opportunity to meet with the Quorum Court in their deliberation of his removal.
- (d) Appeals from removal from the CCJAB shall be directed to the Carroll County Circuit Court within thirty (30) days after the Quorum Court confirms the removal.

SECTION 5: Repeal.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: Severability.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are declared severable.
