ORDINANCE 1999-05

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CHICOT, STATE OF ARKANSAS: AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENTS OF THE MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNOR'S OF THE LAKE VILLAGE CHICOT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL.

SECTION 1. The Arkansas County Compliance Guide, Chapter 263 Board of Governors, County Hospital, ... Section 14-263-104 determines specific requirements for the creation of a County Hospital Board of Governors. The Board of Governors shall consist of seven(7) members who shall be appointed by the County Judge and approved by the Quorum Court, each serving for a term of seven years, commencing in July 1 and ending on June 30.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1997-9 approved by the Quorum Court on July 24th, 1997 approved the seven members presently serving on the Board of Governors for the Lake Village Chicot Memorial Hospital. Several of the member's terms noted a term ending with months other than June 30th and Mabel Allen's term should have been stated as June, 2001.

SECTION 3. The Lake Village Chicot Memorial Hospital, Board of Governors, shall consist of the following members with designated terms as stated:

SECTION 4. Appointment of the above named qualified persons to serve on the Lake Village Chicot Memorial Hospital Board of Governors as shown, is by adoption of this Ordinance, approved. The Chicot County Judge shall be the ex-officio member of this Board.

SECTION 5. That if any provisions of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, will be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
