BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO PURCHASE PRISONER FOOD ON A CASH BASIS.

ARTICLE 1.

It is recognized that prisoner food can be obtained by the Sheriff's office at less cost on a cash basis. Therefore the Marion County Sheriff's Office is authorized to create and maintain a fund of up to \$500.00 in cash for the purpose of purchasing prisoner food on a cash basis. The Sheriff's Office shall submit food purchase receipts for food purchased with this fund when filing claims to replenish this fund.




